	<u>Glass</u>	<u>Bottle</u>
<b>Yellowtail Chardonnay</b> (Australia) <i>This wine has a lovely peachy vanilla and coconut aroma, with a rich creamy toasted finish on the palate while being silky smooth and easy to drink.</i>	\$5.50	\$21
<b>Citra Pinot Grigio</b> (Italy) <i>This dry, light, crisp wine has bright straw yellow color with the delicate and pleasing aroma of fresh fruit.</i>	\$5.25	\$19
<b>Heron Hill Riesling</b> (New York) <i>A delicate floral aroma followed by peach and ripe melon flavors with a soft, lingering finish.</i>	\$6.50	\$24
<b>Heron Hill Eclipse White</b> (New York) <i>An exotic blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris. This aromatic, fruit-driven wine is perfectly balanced and semi-dry.</i>		\$29
<b>Kendall Jackson Chardonnay</b> (California) <i>Layered aromas of green apples, peaches, honey and vanilla balance flavors of baked apples, lemon, pineapple and mango. A hint of spiced nuts and a suggestion of toasted oak round out the lingering finish.</i>	\$8.75	\$33
<b>Matua Sauvignon Blanc</b> (New Zealand) <i>Light green in color, citrus and lemon fruits dominate the nose. The palate is generous and full with typical Sauvignon Blanc acidity.</i>		\$25
<b>Big House White</b> (California) <i>Big House White is a crisp yet round wine with a floral nose, accentuated by honeysuckle, and a bit of a tropical fruit cocktail. A virtual potpourri of fruits including cantaloupe, peach, and apricot. The finish is fairly long with a nice apricot character</i>	\$5.75	\$22
<b>Chateau St Michelle Chardonnay</b> (Washington) <i>This is a fresh, soft style of Chardonnay with bright sweet citrus fruit character and subtle spice and oak nuances.</i>		\$27
<b>Mezzacorona Pinot Grigio</b> (Italy) <i>Refreshing and rich, this Pinot Grigio from Wine Enthusiast Magazine's European Winery of the Year is balanced with bright acidity because the grapes come from the cool climate vineyards in Northern Italy's Dolomite mountains, this is a great wine to enjoy over and over again.</i>		\$24
<b>Valley of the Moon Chardonnay</b> (California) <i>Aromas of tropical citrus and vanilla are followed by flavors of nectarine and spice. The rich, full-bodied texture is accented by hints of toasty oak, and balanced with bright green apple acidity on the finish</i>		\$25
<b>Toasted Head Chardonnay</b> (California) <i>The nose offers ripe pineapple and peach aromas with toasted graham cracker. The bright straw color prepares the palate for the rich tropical fruit and luscious stone fruit with a viscous mouth feel accented by toasted coconut, vanilla and butterscotch. The creamy finish lingers with hints of buttered toast and lemon zest. This wine will pair well with creamy Italian pasta dishes, roasted chicken or fish.</i>		\$31

<b>Nathanson Creek White Zinfandel</b> (California) <i>Light and fresh with watermelon and citrus-like flavors. Sweet but balanced with medium acidity and floral berry aromas. This White Zinfandel is delicious as an aperitif, with spicy dishes, or with most light foods.</i>	\$4.75	\$19

## Reds

<b>Yellowtail Cabernet</b> (Australia) <i>This Cabernet Sauvignon leaps from the glass with a touch of mint and aromas of blackberries, chocolate and vanilla. The seamless structure shows rich berry flavors, peppered with spice. The palate is tremendously long and well-structured with toasted oak supporting soft fruit and velvety tannins.</i>	\$5.50	\$21
<b>Camelot Merlot</b> (California) <i>This Merlot exhibits dark plum and ripe berry fruit aromas with hints of sweet oak. On the palate the wine has a mouth filling, well structured foundation of Bing Cherry and dark fruit flavors revealing notes of cracked black pepper and caraway in the long elegant finish. Try this wine with red-sauced pasta dishes or grilled meats.</i>	\$5.50	\$21
<b>Yellowtail Shiraz</b> (Australia) <i>Yellowtail shiraz is made with grapes sourced from the highest quality vineyards. It bounds forward from the glass with berry and smooth vanilla aromas, subdued earthy tones with soft ripe sweetness are displayed in perfect harmony with fine tannins</i>	\$5.50	\$21
<b>Straccali Chianti</b> (Italy) <i>Made up of 85% Sangiovese; 15% Canaiolo and Merlot. It boasts vibrant ruby red color with bright, youthful aromas of ripe red fruit. Velvety and refreshing with good structure.</i>	\$6.25	\$24
<b>XY Zinfandel</b> (California) <i>Ruby red in color with the sheen of a tree-ripe cherry. A gracious wine, with aroma of rose, pomegranate, and brown sugar. Strawberry, and plum dominate the entry and lead to a finish of dark cherries, mulberries and chocolate.</i>	\$7.50	\$28
<b>Mirassou Pinot Noir</b> (California) <i>Mirassou California Pinot Noir displays fresh fruit flavors of pomegranates, cherries and currants with complementing aromas of strawberries, pomegranates and cherries.</i>		\$23
<b>Colores Del Sol- Malbec</b> (Argentina) <i>This wine has been crafted in a distinct style, combining cutting-edge winemaking skills with the authenticity and singular charm of the Malbec grape. It offers elegant aromatics, and a palate which frames bright, fresh fruit flavors in a medium-bodied structure.</i>	\$6.00	\$23
<b>7 Deadly Zins- Zinfandel</b> (California) <i>Notes of sweet plums and pepper dominate the nose, while flavors of blueberry, raspberry, cinnamon, and black pepper pack the palate from start to finish. The silky-smooth tannins hold the wine together and deliver a soft, fruit driven experience.</i>		\$36
<b>Tapeña Tempranillo</b> (Spain) <i>The quintessential red wine grape from Spain, Tempranillo (temp-rah-NEE-yo), is a rich, bold blend of fruit, earth and structure, rounded out by a deliciously soft mouthfeel. This wine captures the character of luscious red cherry fruit, a long finish layered with a hint of coffee and chocolate and a pinch of spice.</i>	\$5.50	\$21
<b>Chateau St Michelle Cabernet</b> (Washington) <i>Aged 16 months in American and French oak this inviting Cabernet has plenty of complexity and structure. It's also very versatile with food-try it with beef, pork or pasta.</i>		\$32
<b>Red Diamond Merlot</b> (Australia) <i>Aromas of sweet cherry and cream soda introduce this Merlot. The soft palate displays flavors of red berries, juicy plums and a touch of caramel, the finish is soft and inviting</i>		\$24
<b>St Francis Sonoma Red</b> (California) <i>A succulent blend (Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, and Cabernet Franc), RED is lush with succulent ripe fruit flavors and spicy aromas. Full-bodied and versatile.</i>		\$27
<b>Ménage à Trois (Red)</b> (California) <i>Ménage à Trois (Zinfandel, Merlot and Cabernet) exposes the fresh, ripe, jam like fruit that is the calling card of California wine. Forward, silky and soft, this delicious dalliance makes the perfect accompaniment for spicy red sauces or chicken.</i>		\$25
